HEALTH AND SAFETY POLICY

Part 1: Statement of Intent

This is the health & safety policy statement of Amphill and Flitwick Flyers RC.
Our health & safety policy is to:

- Consult with our Committee and members on matters affecting Health and Safety
- Provide adequate training for all our coaches to ensure training sessions are run safely
- To review and revise this policy regularly.

Part 2: Responsibilities for health & safety

Overall and final responsibility for health & safety lies collectively with the Club Committee.
Day-to-day responsibility for ensuring this policy is put into practice is delegated to the clubs Welfare officer(s) Mark Waine and Samantha Walters.

To ensure health & safety standards are maintained/improved the committee will receive reports/recommendations on a need's basis and act where appropriate.

- All club members are expected to cooperate on health & safety matters.
- All club members must take reasonable care of their own health & safety.
- All club members must report all health & safety concerns as soon as practically possible, and ideally immediately, to the club's welfare officer(s) or committee members.

Part 3: Arrangements for health & safety

- Risk assessments – we will complete relevant risk assessments that will be published on the club's website. The risk assessments will be reviewed on a regular basis and act when necessary.
- Training - where appropriate/specific training is required this will be arranged.
